None	Extend Solar Act of 2021 to 2032	BPU initiative. MSSIA to participate/support
S225	Distributed storage incentive program	Amendments submitted to Smith
S2816	Grid Modernization – “low-hanging fruit”	Must remove added “poison pill paragraph” and add teeth.
S237	Clean Energy Standard	Needs amendments
S4100	Instant online permitting for solar projects	Signed?
S3737	Closes loopholes in 20-year time horizon law	MSSIA working on it
S4530	3,000 MW of Community Solar on Aug. 1	Done. Influence roll-out as much as possible
S4289	Transmission-level storage	Done. Little or no action needed.
S4300	SACP reductions for legacy projects	On hold. Likelihood of revival low.
S258	Grid Modernization – funding	Back burner
